### **Redesigned SAT info sessions**

Parents of students in grades 6-12 are invited to learn about the redesigned SAT during six parent information nights scheduled around the district. The College Board will share with parents the redesigned SAT that will begin in March 2016, including the new system for scoring the SAT, the contents of the test, including the different test sections and specific types of questions students will be answering.
