Best Practices for Virtual Learners:

- 1. Parents and students must check their email daily for primary communication with teachers.
- 2. Students are required to submit daily attendance in their Google classrooms.
- 3. Ask questions and communicate with your teachers.
- 4. Check your Google classroom stream for announcements.
- 5. Complete all assignments, videos, assessments in your Google classroom.
- 6. Check prior assignments for feedback from your teachers.
- 7. Attend scheduled meetings and office hours with your teachers.

The HCMS faculty and staff are planning for next semester and we'd like parents and families to start planning as well. Here are some key notes to consider as we prepare for second semester!!

- Second semester starts Tuesday, January 5th.
- For the second semester, students can participate in either face to face or virtual instruction as selected in the Back to School Survey.
