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Student Attendance

As of now, all students should be in the appropriate classes and have access to Google Meets and Google Classroom codes. If any student does not have the correct codes, parents and students are asked to contact classroom teachers directly. To be counted present for any class, students must sign the daily attendance log and participate in live instruction. When students participate in independent learning days, the daily attendance log must be signed by 3:10pm daily. Students who fail to show up to class during live instruction or sign the daily attendance log by 3:10pm during independent learning days will be counted absent.

Supporting Onsite Learning for Virtual Education (SOLVE)

Do you need additional assistance to support your student during universal remote learning? You're in luck!! SOLVE is part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) funding allocated to Georgia through the CARES Act and is in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. It is administered by the Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS) Program located within the Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL).
