Summer School Update

Session I

- June 3 – July 15 (33 days)
- Virtual Summer School
- This will be completely run by FVS.
- Students who need to clear incompletes **OR** who failed a course can choose to go to FVS.
- The courses will be free for course failures and incompletes.
- For students who go to FVS to clear the incomplete; they will complete the entire second semester.

Session II

- June 1st - June 25th (19 days)
- Facilitated by HCMS teaching staff
- Remote Learning via Google Meets
- Sessions for students who need to clear incompletes.
- Students must log on to each class and complete the assignments from March – May.
- Teachers will log in on multiple days and may have multiple groups.
